1. Call to Order and Announcements: Dr. Ford called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm substituting for Dr. Roselle. Commission members were again invited to submit items for future CUS meetings.
2. The Agenda was amended to include an item for Faculty authored textbooks. A motion to approve the agenda as amended was seconded and passed.
3. The minutes of the CUS meeting of September 30, 1986, were approved as distributed.
4. Dean Egger moved to approve semester course proposals as recommended by the Course Proposals Review Committee. The motion was seconded and passed. The departmental proposals approved were Mining and Minerals Engineering; Family and Child Development; and Housing, Interior Design, and Resource Management.
5. Dr. Purcell presented four faculty authored textbooks for approval. One text was referred to the Commission on Graduate Studies because it will be used for a graduate course. With this deletion a motion for approval of the remaining three texts was seconded and passed. The list as amended is attached to the minutes.
6. Dean Ogliaruso presented Resolution 86-87A to the commission. The purpose of the resolution is to inform students and advisors that it is extremely important to complete all quarter sequences and/or clusters that have been started or will be started before the University converts to the semester system. The resolution was amended to help insure adequate distribution of the information contained in the resolution. The amended resolution was presented for approval. The motion was seconded and passed. A copy of the amended resolution is attached.
7. Under other business, Dr. Vasey suggested that the Provost's office assume responsibility for reminding students of the newly implemented Freshman Rule. It was also suggested that all faculty advisors and students should be reminded that clusters and/or sequences taken to fulfill the University Core requirement must be taken on an A/F grade basis.
8. The meeting adjourned at 3:30 pm.
