

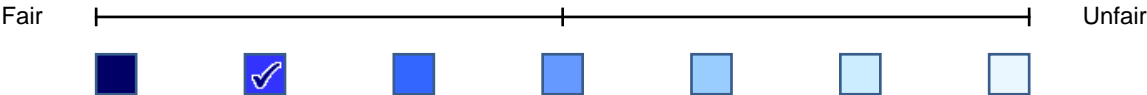

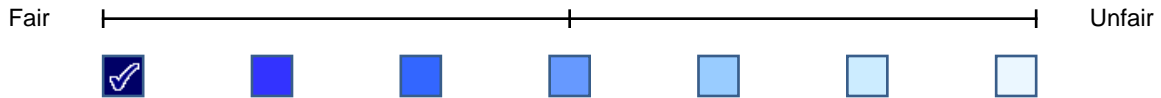

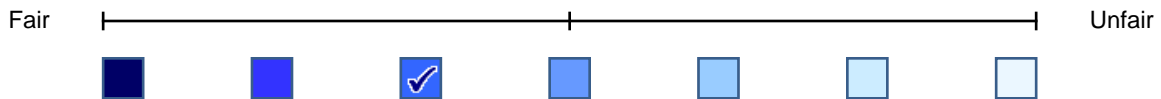

[+] Original work was not created and/or has not been marketed for the stated purpose of the proposed use



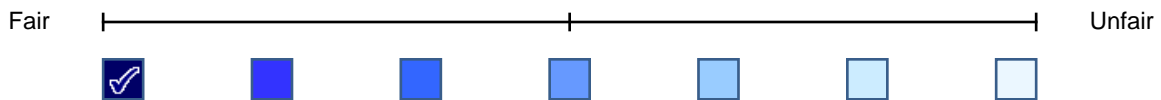
Describe the **Amount** of Your Intended Use in Relation to the Copyrighted Work as a Whole:

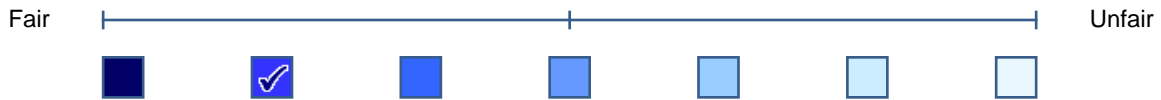
