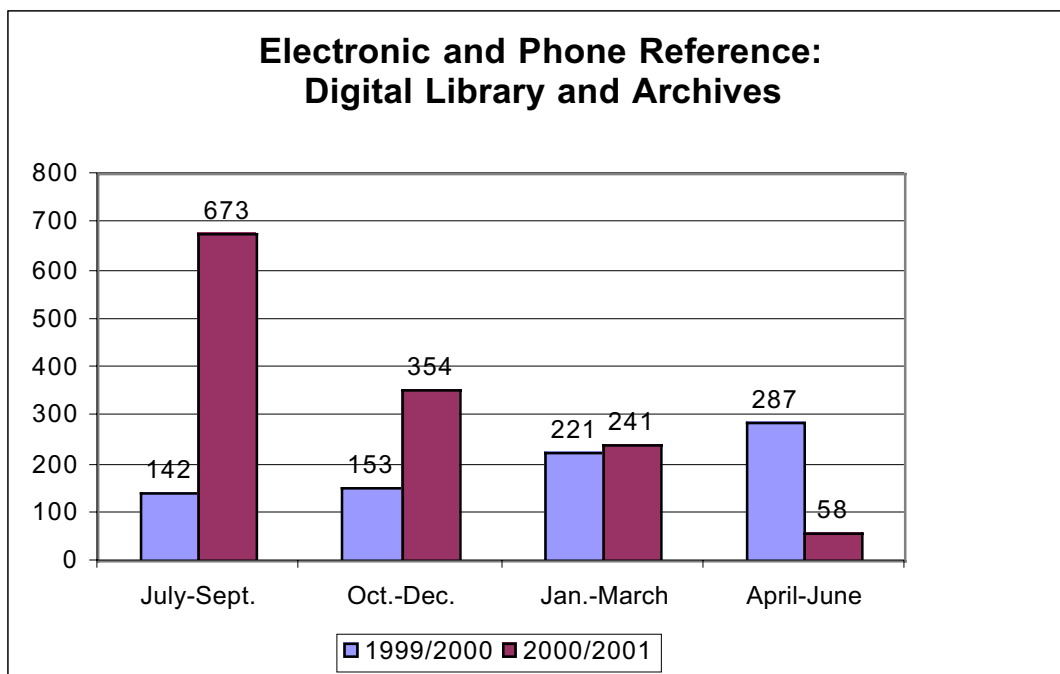

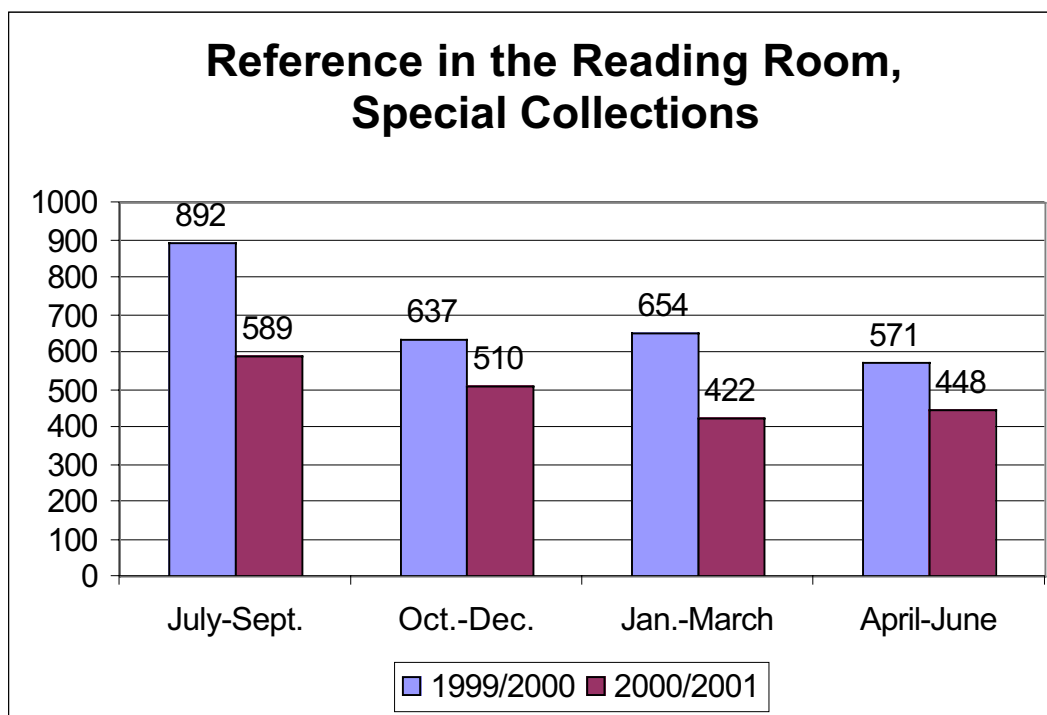

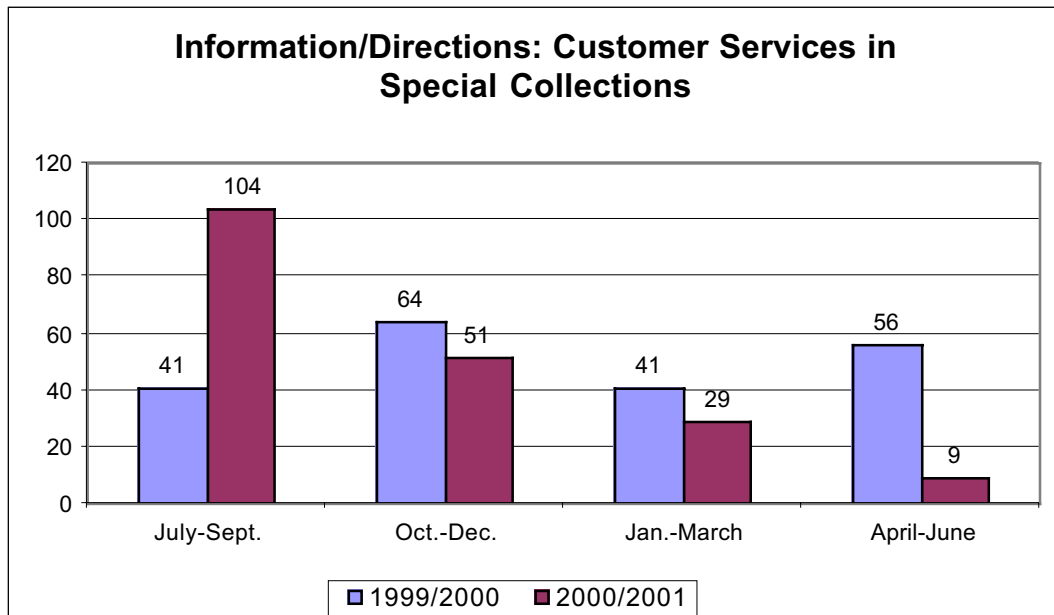
Customer Services statistics from Special Collections and the Digital Library and Archives
