

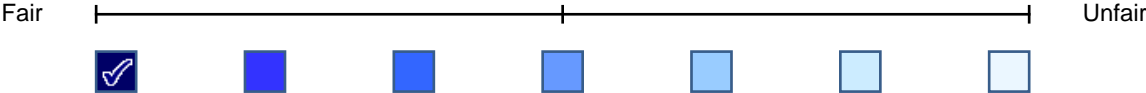

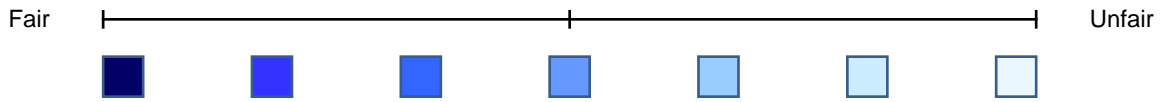

Dissertation review of the work I undertook during my PhD study. I published two articles during this time, of which the figures that I created for those publications are used in the dissertation.



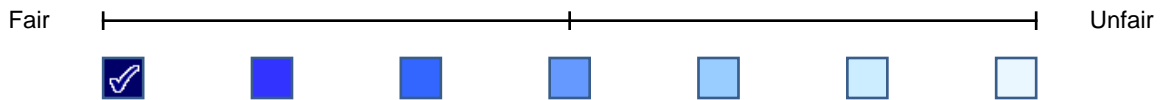

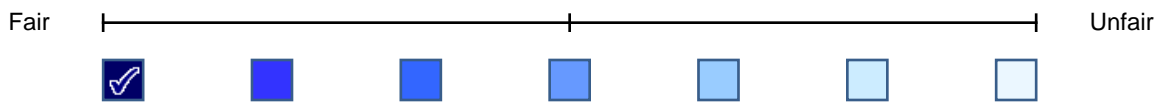

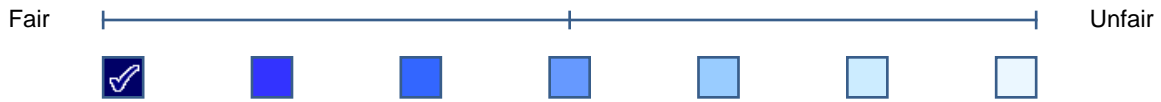
