Sept 2019: Get VText & Google Scholar

What is Get VText?

Many of the indexes/databases available through the library do not actually provide full-text access to the information that appears in the search results.

To determine if we do have access, look for the  icon. By clicking on this, a search across the library's holdings will either pull up the content through the provider, or if we don't have access, provide an option to request the material through [Interlibrary Loan](#).

How do I set up Get VText in Google Scholar?

When you search through Google Scholar on campus, your IP may connect you through to the content. However, if you're off campus, you'll be asked to pay to access the content, even if the library has a subscription (or can get it through Interlibrary Loan at no cost to you).

A simple way to make sure you can quickly connect to the library's resources no matter where you are, is to set up Get VText in Google Scholar. This [short video](#) (1:46) shows how to do that.
